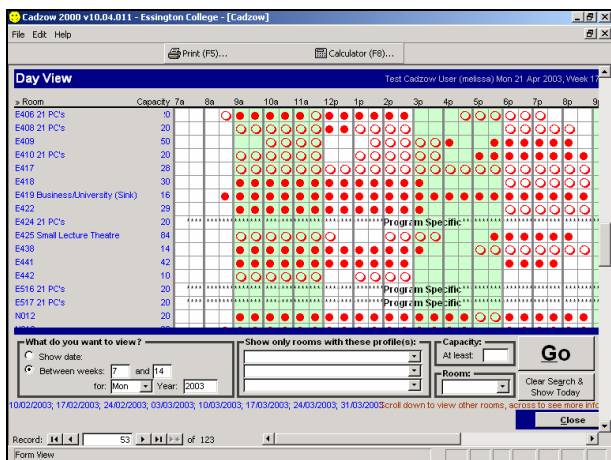

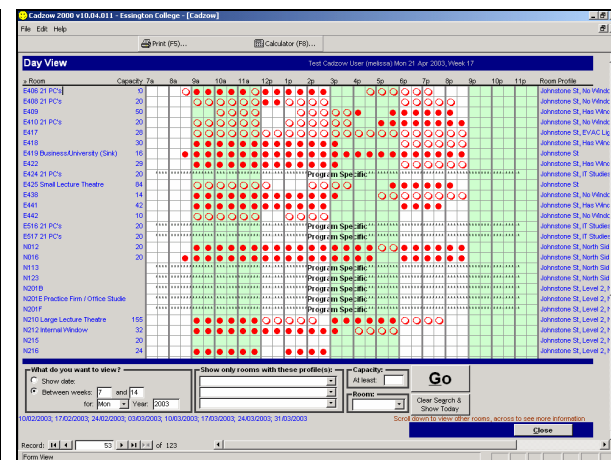
CADZOW SOFTWARE: Screen Resizing

Cadzow 2000 will automatically resize many of its screens (such as invoicing and Enquiries) to show more information. Many people run their systems at 800 × 600 but with the increasing prevalence of TFT displays and 17" and 19" monitors you may become more productive with your display at 1024 × 768 or even 1280 × 1024.

To illustrate this, here's some sample screens from the Cadzow Room Booking Manager:

COMPUTING: Remove your Desktop Wallpaper

Microsoft Windows allows you to choose a picture to show as wallpaper on your desktop. However, this can dramatically slow your computer because it requires memory to be allocated and is refreshed every time the desktop is displayed. It is much faster to have a solid colour background. So consider keeping that photo of your kid/dog/car/home/partner next to the computer, instead of on it!

CADZOW SOFTWARE: New Module — Room Booking Manager

Cadzew 2000 has a new module: Room Booking Manager.

Powerful but elegantly simple, it was initially developed for one of South Australian's major educational facilities, with over 120 lecture rooms to be tracked, although it is suitable for any organisation that needs to manage the bookings of rooms.

As a ready made module, it can be easily and quickly deployed. There are many reports, including door sheets, usage reports, confirmation and cancellation statistics etc. See above for some screen shots.

COMPUTING: Free Virus Scanning

If you think you may be infected with something nasty there are some free web-based virus scanners you can use in an emergency:

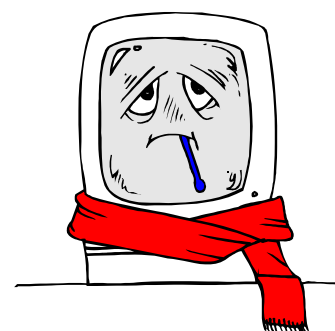

Of course, these scanners will only detect viruses once they are in your system so their main use is as an emergency check, and if a virus has damaged your system these online scanners may not function properly anyway.

As always, the best option is to use a locally-installed virus scanner and keep it up to date. A local virus scanner is designed to detect viruses *before* you are infected.

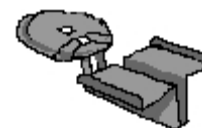
